

External Grant Review Funding

Faculty in Harris College can access up to \$500 in funding to support honorariums for external expert reviewers providing feedback on first- or senior-author grant applications.

This funding aims to facilitate timely and valuable feedback before submission, increasing the likelihood of acceptance.

To utilize this funding, faculty members must have a nearly finalized grant application draft ready for review, and the faculty member should be the principal investigator for the grant application.

To apply for the funding, faculty members should complete the linked application. The application requires:

- 1. Product outlet (grant-funding mechanism)
- 2. Brief explanation of how the review will advance the product
- 3. Suggested expert reviewer with their qualifications

It is not necessary for the reviewer to have confirmed the external reviewer willingness to participate prior to submitting a request for this funding; however, **the faculty member is responsible for reaching out to the external reviewer** to secure their services.

Applications for funding should be submitted through Eva Leon at <u>e.leon@tcu.edu</u>.

The funding is limited and will be granted on a rolling basis. To allow for a timely external review, applicants are advised to submit their funding applications well in advance, considering a potential month-long period between the application and the completion of the external review.
